The Organising Authority, Royal Freshwater Bay Yacht Club (Inc), Perth, Western Australia in Association with the respective Class Associations has pleasure in inviting you to participate in the 2010 International Classes Regatta.

1. **Rules**

The Regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the YA Prescriptions and Special Regulations, the rules of the respective Classes (except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions) and by the Sailing Instructions.

2. **Alterations of Class Rules**

Optimists – Refer to Item 8.1

3. **Alterations of Racing Rules**

Not applicable

4. **Advertising**

The regatta is classified as a Category 'C' event in accordance with Appendix 1 and the prescriptions of the YA.

5. **Eligibility and Entry**

5.1 The *Keane's Point Championship* will be open to skippers who are financial members of their respective Class Associations as listed:

5.2 The *Captain O M Watts Regatta* will be open to skippers who are financial members of either the WA International Optimist Dinghy Association (WAIODA) or any other International Optimist Dinghy Association and who are sailing boats that comply with Class rules as specified in 8.1.

5.3 Eligible boats may enter on the attached Entry Form, which shall be lodged with the Yachting Operations Assistant at the Royal Freshwater Bay Yacht Club by **Friday, 26 November 2010** accompanied by the required fee.

Late entries will be accepted, however an additional fee of A\$15.00 will be required.

5.4 A minimum of 6 entries will be required for each class and a minimum of 5 starters for each race.

6. **Fees**
 Regatta Entry \$25.00 per Optimist Bronze Fleet
 \$40.00 per single person boat
 \$80.00 per two person boat

Late Entry Fee \$15.00 in addition to the applicable Regatta Entry Fee.

If you are unable to complete the series there is a provision to pay \$10.00 per race. Nevertheless you will not be recorded in the Series Results.

8. **Measurement**

8.1 **Captain O M Watts Regatta - Optimist Class Only**

A measurement certificate will not be required for Optimists, however, all boats entered will have to verify that hull weight, spar dimensions, rudder, centerboard and sail complies with Class Rules.

Keane's Point Championship - 505, 470, 420, 49er, 29er, Laser, Mirror, Contender Classes

A copy of a current measurement certificate must be submitted with the entry.

8.2 Random measurement checks and inspections may be carried out in all classes at any time.

9. **Sailing Instructions**

Sailing Instructions will be available to all entries accepted by the Race Committee at Registration.

10. **Regatta Site**

The RFBYC Junior Clubhouse building and adjacent rigging lawns will be the Regatta Site. The regatta office, notice board and signal mast will be located there. Canteen and shower/toilet facilities are available.

11. **Racing Area**

The racing area will be on the waters of the Swan River known as Freshwater Bay (FB), which is in close proximity to the Royal Freshwater Bay Yacht Club and/or Melville Water West (MWW).

12. **Courses**

The course for all classes will be either triangular or windward/leeward or trapezoid configurations as described in the Sailing Instructions.

13. **Scoring**

The Low Point Scoring System Rule A.4.1 will apply as modified by the sailing instructions.

14 Prizes

14.1 Prizes will be awarded for:

Championship places overall

Handicap places overall

No boat is eligible to win more than one overall prize in any one championship.

Number of places awarded is subject to the number of entries.

Bronze Fleet – A separate prize program will be awarded.

15. Liability

All those taking part in this Regatta do so at their own risk and responsibility. RFBYC is not responsible for the seaworthiness of a boat whose entry is accepted or the sufficiency or adequacy of its equipment. RFBYC reserves the right to refuse an entry. Attention is drawn to Racing Rule(RRS) 4 - Decision to Race which places the sole responsibility for a boat deciding to participate in a race or to continue racing as hers alone”.

16. Insurance Cover

All competing helmspersons shall have Third Party Liability and Public Liability insurance cover of not less than AUD\$5,000,000 (recommended \$10,000,000) for any one accident. By signing the Entry Form, helmspersons are deemed to have made a declaration that they have such cover.

17. Results

Results will be posted as soon as possible after each day’s racing

18. Presentation of Trophies

Presentation Function will be held at RFBYC Junior Clubhouse on Sunday, 5 December 2010 commencing as soon as practical after the last race. An invitation is extended to all competitors and their friends.
