NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the special regulations of Yachting Australia Inc, the rules of the Laser, Tasar, International 420, Mirror, 29er, Access dinghy, BIC dinghy and Optimist classes (except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions) and by the sailing instructions.

2. ALTERATION OF CLASS RULES

There will be no alterations to Class Rules.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1. The regatta is open to the following classes:

- Laser (Full Rig, Radial and 4.7)
- Tasar
- International 420
- 29er
- Optimist gold/silver
- Access dinghies
- BIC dinghies
- Mirror

3.2. All Entrants must be holders of a current Yachting Australia Silver/Youth Card.

3.3. Eligible boats may enter on the attached Entry Form, which shall be lodged with:

BY 1500 ON FRIDAY 11th FEBRUARY 2011, accompanied by the required fee.

3.4. The following restrictions on the number of boats apply:

A class or sub-class shall have a minimum of five boats ranking as entries to be eligible for prizes. If four or less entries are received by the closing date for entries then the class or sub-class may be combined with the nearest competitive class or sub-class at the sole discretion of the Race Committee.

4. FEES

4.1. Regatta entry fee

4.2. Late entries will not be accepted, this is due to safety reasons.

5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

5.1. Registration

Saturday 12th February 2010 from 0730 to 0830 only.

5.2. Welcome and Competitors Meeting

There will be a welcome followed by a competitors meeting at 0830 on Saturday 12 February 2011 in the Royal Perth Yacht Club Dinghy Division Clubhouse.

5.3. Races

The regatta will consist of up to 10 races over two days – 12 and 13 February 2011. The first warning signal for any event will not be made before 0930 on the first scheduled day of racing. The schedule of races will be set out in the sailing instructions. It is intended to have a break for lunch with racing continuing in the afternoon of both days, at the discretion of the Race Officer.

6. MEASUREMENT

All competing yachts shall conform to the measurement requirements of their respective class rules. Random measurement checks and inspections may be carried out in any class at any time.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will only be available from 0700 on Saturday 12 February 2011, from the Royal Perth Yacht Club Dinghy Division Clubhouse.

8. REGATTA SITE

The regatta site will be the Royal Perth Yacht Club (Dinghy Division) Australia II Drive, Crawley.

9. RACING AREA

The racing area will be on the waters of the Swan River known as Matilda Bay and Melville water east, which are in close proximity to the Royal Perth Yacht Club.

10. COURSES

The course shall be a windward - leeward or windward - leeward - triangle / trapezoid configuration as described in the sailing instructions. Fleets will be split to 2 different race areas.

11. SCORING

The Low Point Scoring system, Appendix A.4.1 shall apply.

12. PROTEST MEDIATION

Protests arising from participation in this regatta shall be subject to mediation as detailed in the sailing instructions.

13. SUPPORT BOATS

Support personnel shall keep clear of all boats racing unless assisting a boat in distress or standing by a capsized boat.

14. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded providing the yacht has completed a minimum of 5 races, for the first three placegetters in each Class or Division.

15. ADVERTISING

Competitors may be required to display the event sponsors name(s) / logo(s) and / or bow numbers in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.3(d)(i). If required, these items will be supplied by the Organising Authority and shall be affixed as prescribed in the sailing instructions.

16. INSURANCE

All competing helmspersons shall have third party insurance cover of not less than AUD\$5,000,000 (recommended \$10,000,000) for any one accident. By signing the Entry Form, helmspersons have made a declaration that they have such cover.

17. LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk.

Attention is drawn to RRS 4 "Decision to Race" which states "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone."

Those taking part in this regatta are responsible for the seaworthiness of the boat that they are sailing and for the sufficiency and adequacy of its equipment.

The organising authority, its associates and appointees will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death or inconvenience sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

18. WARNING

Sailing and activities associated with it involve risks of personal injury, loss and damage and even death. The risks include but are not limited to, the risk of injury

from collision, capsizing, falling overboard, being trapped under the sail or boat after capsize, and impact with equipment. Any of these events can also result in death.

The risks involved in this activity are heightened by:

- Adverse weather conditions
- Inadequate training
- Fatigue
- Inexperience
- Failure to maintain the boat
- Failure to supply and use the recommended safety equipment
